

We had a busy year at the club with improvements all around. We finished the outdoor pistol range and targets, and installed the new pole building with new electrical service. We also made upgrades to the mother club, including electrical, sewage, A/C and heating. We planted 140 white pine trees along the property line beyond the skeet fields, and green giant thujas along the hill on the outdoor pistol range. There were also upgrades to the rifle range, and we added new benches and tables around the club. The captains maintained the ranges by making minor improvements to equipment and to the ranges themselves. Many thanks to everyone who assisted in these endeavors to make our club better.

Kids Fish Day was a huge success with more than 150 child participants. The eagles and ospreys returned to participate as well. There was a boy scout flyfishing event with Trout Unlimited at the pond that went very well and they look forward to returning next year. Scouts were able to obtain merit badges. There were two Project Appleseed events that went well, and we are already planning those events again for 2024.

We are looking at more upgrades to the club this year, including mother club refurbishment, building painting or siding, five stand for trap/skeet fields, pond updates, indoor pistol range updates, and planting more trees and shrubbery around the club.

CLUB NEWS TRAP/SKEET

Central Penn Skeet League will begin January 13th & 14th, with the first shoot being held at the club. This is a 100-bird shoot between 4 clubs: Carlisle, Cocalico, North American (Hagerstown, MD) and York & Adams. There are eight shoots, with each club holding two shoots.
